

The Asia Summer Program (ASP) is an international summer program that spans over a period of three weeks. It is designed to delve into topics that are pertinent to individuals around the world. Since its inception in 2012, ASP has been a powerful tool in fostering a connection between different cultures, promoting creativity and collaboration, and inspiring students and faculty members to explore the nuances of our culture and enhance the interconnectedness of our institutions. The program offers a welcoming and multicultural learning environment, where students from various Asian universities can come together both online and onsite.

During the Asia Summer Program, students have the option to choose two courses per day - one in the morning and the other in the afternoon. The courses primarily focus on liberal arts and humanities topics, although some introductory-level courses in other fields are also offered. All courses are taught exclusively in English by instructors from the participating universities.

Typically, each course offered in the Asia Summer Program amounts to 3 academic credits, which can be applied towards the graduation requirements of the students' home university. However, it is important to note that policies may vary among the participating universities. Therefore, it is strongly advised that students discuss matters pertaining to academic credits with the ASP representative at their home university, and possibly also with their academic advisor.

Program Objectives:

- 1. To provide flexibility to students who wish to study online
- 2. To facilitate active learning in various fields through interactive tools and application

ASP 2023: The Connected Classroom offers a study abroad initiative where participating students are able to select from two programs, as follows.

Program A: Powering the Future: How Innovation and Soft Power Drive the World

A 2-week of online learning via Zoom, during July 3-14, 2023, where the participants take 2 courses and earn 6 credits, as described below.

- Course A: Digital Technology and Innovation in Emerging Industries explores the ways in which digital technology and innovation are shaping the world we live in, including our learning and views of the world, during July 3-9, 2023
- Course B: Soft Power and Interconnectedness explores the ways in which we coexist in our global community. The program provides diverse viewpoints through guest lecturers from partner institutions, during July 10-14, 2023

Program A Fee: 400.00 USD, for the registration of two online courses.

Program B: Innovation and Soft Power, with Immersive Learning in Thailand

Program B is a comprehensive learning opportunity that spans over three weeks. The program is divided into two parts: the first two weeks consist of online learning via Zoom, and the third week involves traveling to Bangkok, Thailand, for an immersive cultural learning experience. Participants will be able to earn a total of 9 credits from Bangkok University upon completion of the program, as detailed below.

- Course A: Digital Technology and Innovation in Emerging Industries explores the ways in which digital technology and innovation are shaping the world we live in, including our learning and views of the world, during July 3-9, 2023
- Course B: Soft Power and Interconnectedness explores the ways in which we coexist in our global community. The program provides diverse viewpoints through guest lecturers from partner institutions, during July 10-14, 2023
- Course C: Immersive Learning: A Global Journey in Thailand offers a one-week activity where participants participate in various activities and explore different cultures, during July 16-23, 2023

Program B Fee: 650.00 USD, inclusive of a 2-week online course registration, 7-night accommodation, excursions, meals, airport pick-up and drop-off service
