



Notification of Mae Fah Luang University MFU Partial Scholarship for ASEAN Students 2026

Mae Fah Luang University (MFU) is pleased to announce the opening of applications for four (4) partial scholarships to students from ASEAN countries who wish to pursue Bachelor's degree programmes in the Academic Year 2026. The scholarship aims to support academically outstanding international students and encourage them to excel in their chosen field of study at Mae Fah Luang University.

1. Scholarship Benefits

The scholarship covers tuition fees for the selected programme of study.

2. Number of Scholarship

A total of four (4) scholarships are available.

3. Available Programmes

Applicants may apply for any Bachelor's degree programme offered by MFU in the academic year 2026. A complete list of available programmes is available on the Mae Fah Luang University website: en.mfu.ac.th/admission/admission-guide.html

4. Qualifications and Eligibility

To be eligible for the MFU Partial Scholarship for ASEAN Students, applicants must meet the following criteria:

4.1 Applicants must be citizens of one of the ASEAN member states.

4.2 Applicants must be currently enrolled in, or must have already graduated from the upper secondary education level or its equivalent in their respective countries.

Applicants who are expected to graduate must submit their official high school certificate upon new student registration.

4.3 Applicants must present one of the following minimum English language proficiency test scores. The test result must not exceed two years from the date of the test.

English Proficiency Test	Test Score
TOEFL (IBT)	72
TOEFL (ITP)	543
IELTS	6
TOEIC (Listening and Reading)	785

5. Selection Process

Scholarships will be awarded based on the applicant's academic performance and their demonstrated potential to contribute to the development of global citizenship within the University community. This potential will be assessed based on the proposed plans and activities outlined in the Statement of Purpose submitted with the scholarship application.

6. Scholarship Conditions

The awardees are required to adhere to the following conditions throughout their studies:

- a) Maintain a semester GPA of 2.50 or higher.
- b) Contribute at least 30 hours per semester to job assistance at Mae Fah Luang University.
- c) Implement the activity or initiative proposed in the Statement of Purpose during the first or second year of study.
- d) Pursue their studies diligently and maintain good conduct.
- e) Comply with university rules and regulations.
- f) Participate regularly in university extracurricular activities.
- g) Stay updated with university news and announcements.
- h) Report academic results to the Global Relations Division within two weeks of the announcement of grades each semester until graduation.
- i) Seek permission from the Scholarship Committee before applying for other scholarship.

7. Failure to comply with the conditions stipulated above may result in the termination of the scholarship.

8. How to Apply

Interested and qualified applicants must complete the online Scholarship Application Form by 31 March 2026 through the link: <https://applicant.mfu.ac.th/registeren/login> and submit the following documents via the online system:

- A recent 1-inch passport-style photograph.
- A certified copy of the high school certificate or a certificate of expected graduation, along with a certified English translation if the original certificate was not issued in English.
- A certified copy of high school transcripts, along with a certified English translation if the original academic transcripts were not issued in English.
- A copy of the applicant's passport.
- A Statement of Purpose describing the applicant's reasons for choosing the programme, as well as the concrete activity or initiative they propose to implement by positioning themselves as leaders or key facilitators in fostering 'global citizenship' among students and staff within the University.
- A recommendation letter from an advisor or a teacher at the applicant's current secondary school.
- An English proficiency test score report (TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC)
- A certified medical report from a licensed doctor.

9. Announcement of Awardees

Scholarship awardees will be announced in May 2026 on the MFU website (www.mfu.ac.th). Successful applicants will receive a confirmation letter via email.
